Marguerite attended St. Mary's Grammar School and graduated from St. Mary's High School. She worked at the Arlington Trust Company after graduating from high school and until starting her family; nineteen years later and she returned to work at Shawmut Bank, formerly Arlington Trust Company until her retirement. She was proud to return to school later in life, attending Northern Essex Community College and excelling in each of the courses she took.

She married her cherished husband, Albert, in 1957, and together they built a life centered around family and love. They truly were soulmates and best friends, as many who knew them will attest.

Nothing brought Marguerite more joy than being with her family, of which she was fiercely proud and protective. Beautiful times were spent together on holidays, birthdays, and many other special occasions-memories her children now cherish.
